

DROUGHT RELIEF SURCHARGE

APPLICABILITY

This schedule is applicable to all customers, whenever the following condition occurs. This Surcharge shall become applicable only after the Department of Water Resources (<http://cdec.water.ca.gov/snow/bulletin120>) April Bulletin 120 reports that for a second year in a row water conditions for the then current Water Year is below average. Once applicable this Surcharge will continue until the next April when the Bulletin 120 report announces that the then current Water Year is above average for the second consecutive year, at which point the Surcharge will be suspended until it becomes applicable again. The Surcharge, if applicable, will begin with the May billing month and end, if applicable, with the April billing month.

RATES

A Drought Relief Surcharge shall be added to all customer monthly bills as follows:

- 1. Energy charge for Rate Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 11, 12 \$0.013 per kWh
- 2. Street and Area lights; Rate Schedules 7 and 8:

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. For billing months May 2010 through April 2011 the above charges will be reduced by 54%, rounded to the same significant digits that appear above.
- 2. The intent of the Surcharge is to restore the Districts' contingency fund used to pay for the affects of the first dry year. If such reserves are expected to exceed \$3 million, the Board of Directors shall meet to determine if a lower Surcharge amount is appropriate and if so how much.
